The Jax of Harmony, formed in 1966, have gained a reputation for providing truly professional entertainment to a variety of audiences throughout a wide geographic area. Their presentations, though based in the traditional barbershop quartet mode, are a combination of music and comedy of various styles which have thrilled nearly a half a million people over the years.

Since winning the Central States District championship in 1972, the Jax have won the right to represent the district in international competition a total of nine times and have repeatedly achieved the rank of international semi-finalists.

In answer to the age-old question, "How ya gonna keep 'em down on the farm?" the Rural Route 4 reply, "We'll be back when we're finished singin'!" And when it comes to barbershop harmony, this quartet will ring chords 'til the cows come home.

The RR4 take their "country bumpkin" routine to entertain audiences across the nation. Since the formation of the quartet in 1971, the RR4 has appeared in some two dozen states and Canada.

The Rural Route 4 also have made their mark as a competing quartet. The foursome won the Central States District championship in 1976 and has competed five times in the international competition of the Society for the Preservation and Encouragement of Barbershop Quartet Singing in America, placing as high as eighth.
